





WHALE SHARK FOOD

Despite its shocking size, it is a gentle and playful animal that can often be found swimming alongside divers and snorkelers. The whale shark is an unusually slow swimmer, averaging a speed of about three miles per hour. It lives in warm ocean waters in tropical climates.




SHARKS BELONG HERE NOT HERE








STEP 1: FIRST, DRAW THE HEAD.




STEP 2: DRAW THE FACE.




STEP 1: THEN, DRAW THE UPPER FINS




STEP 1: DRAW THE LOWER FINS.


SAVE THE VAQUITA






IT'S A WHALE OF A SIZE




Our 3 former coast guard cutters have been instrumental in defending, conserving, and protecting marine life.



OUR FLEET


