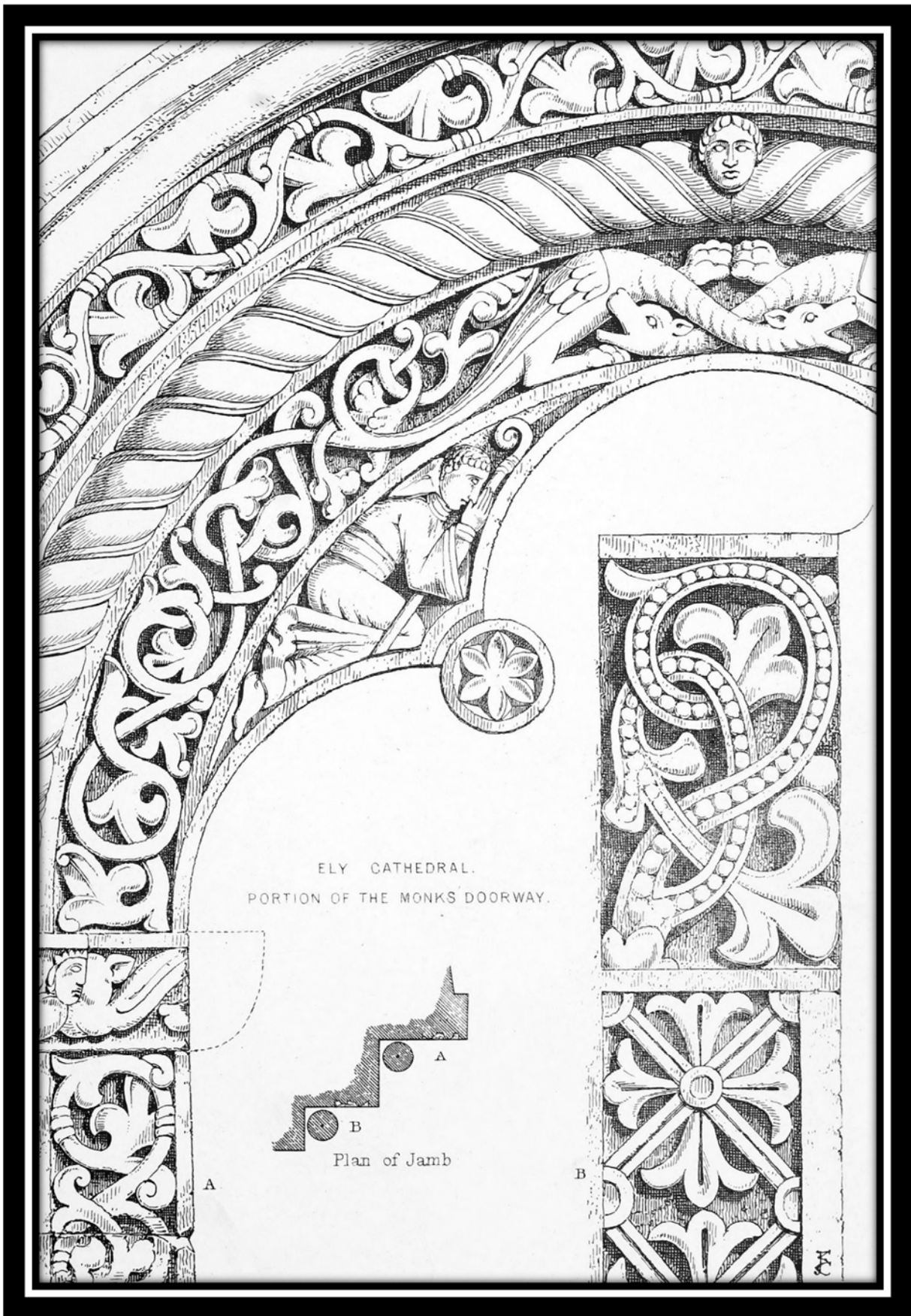


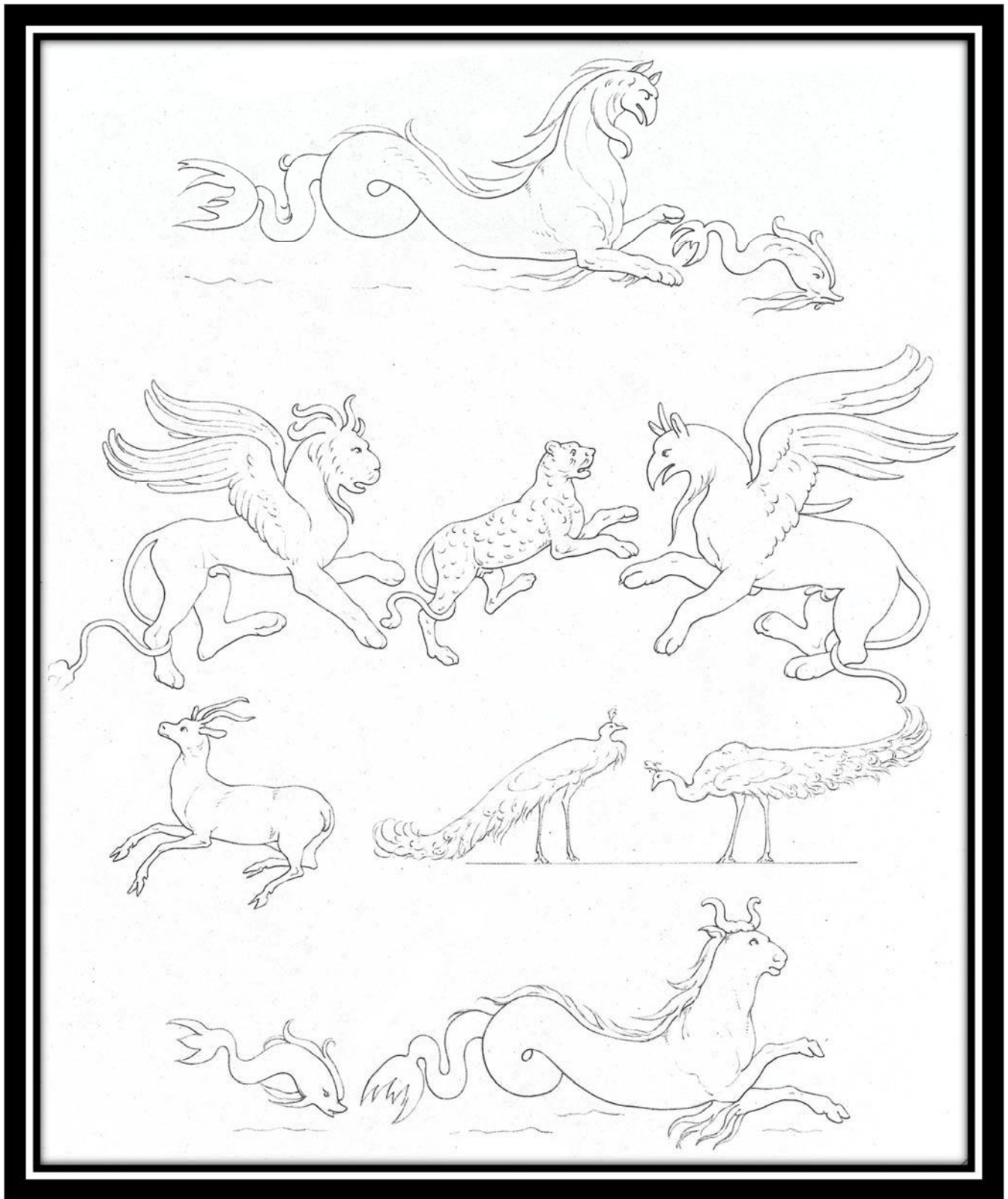
Plate 1 from *Examples of English medieval foliage* by James Kellaway Colling, 1874.

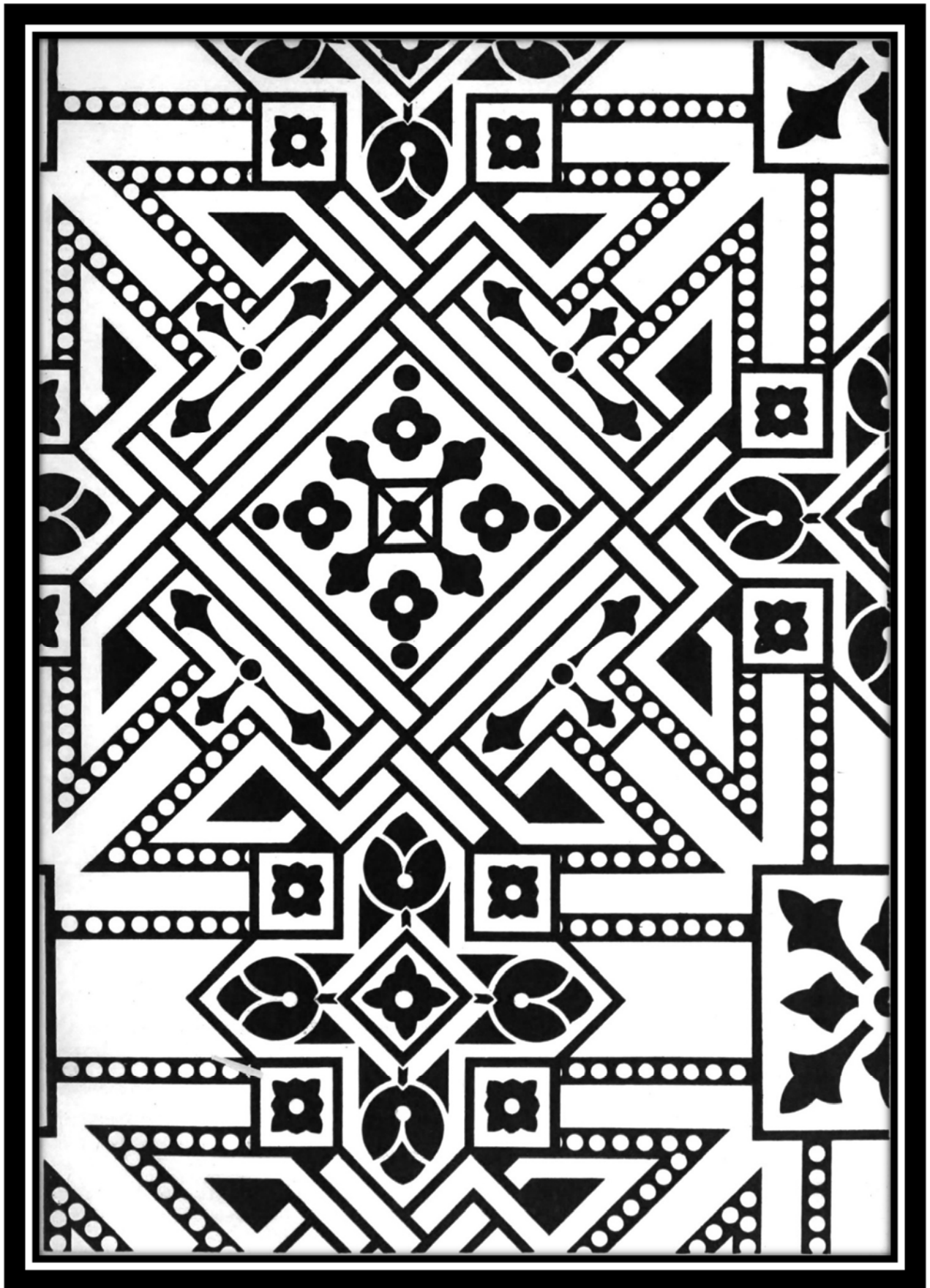


Plate XXXIII from *Studies in Design* by Christopher Dresser, 1876.
