

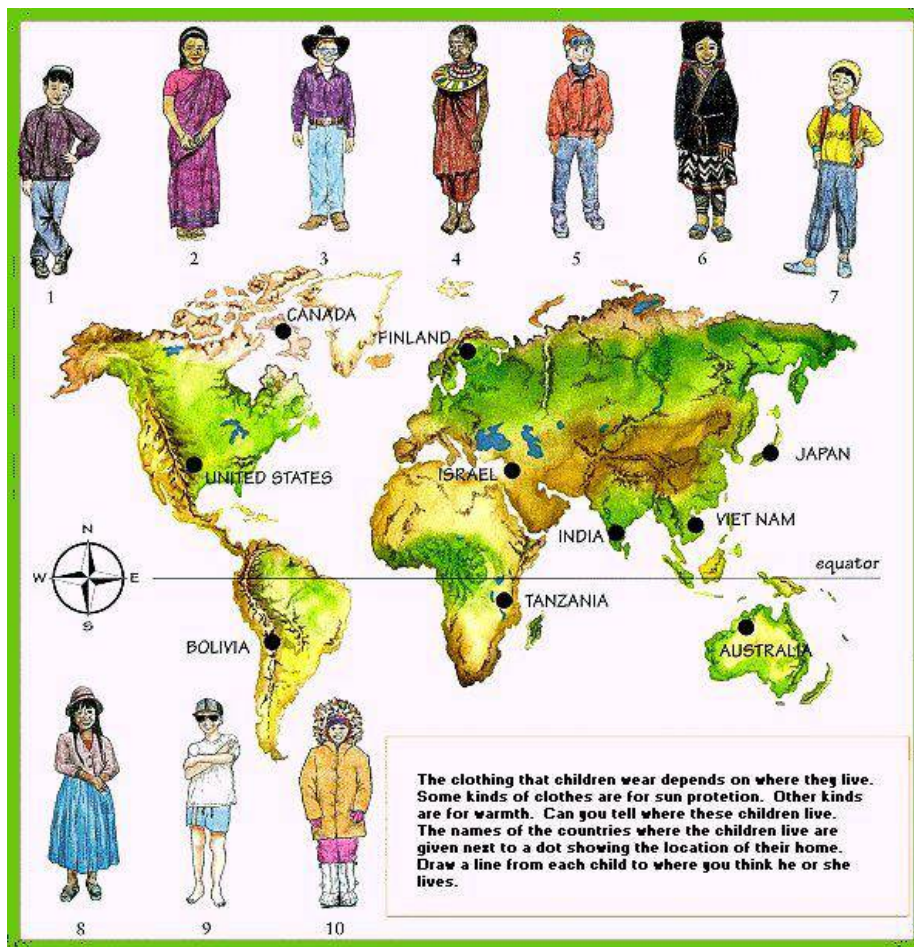


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A Matching Game for You!

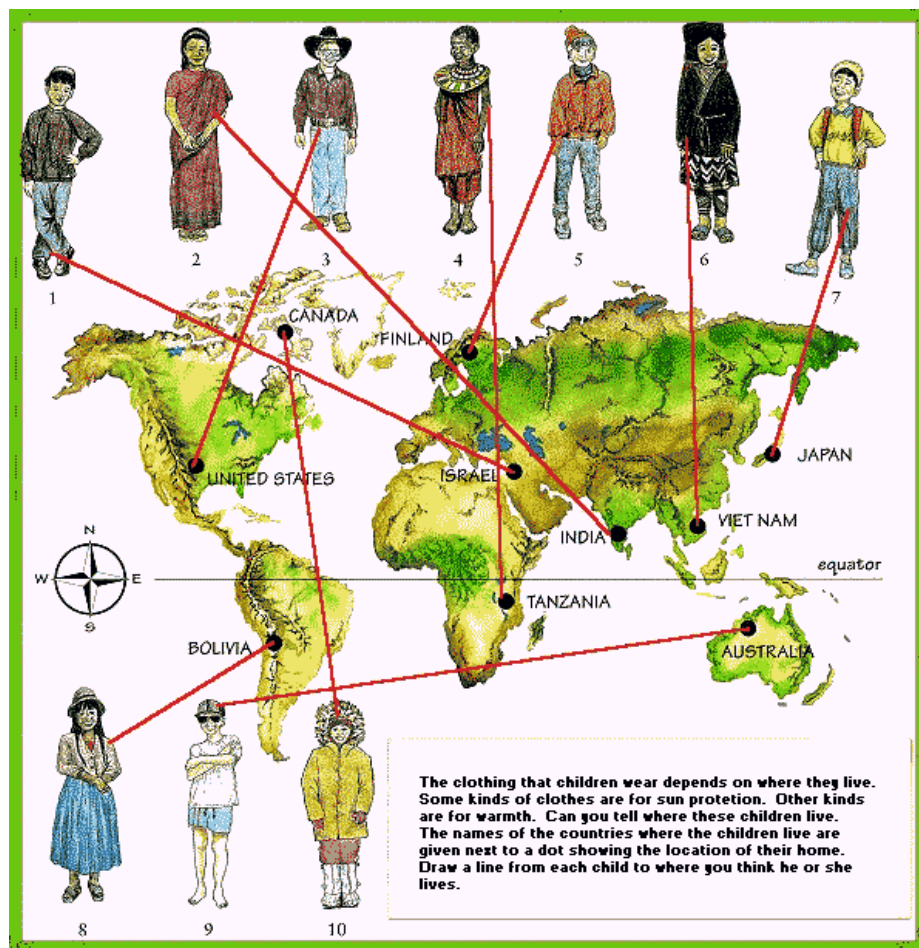
Can you tell where these children live by the clothes they are wearing?
