

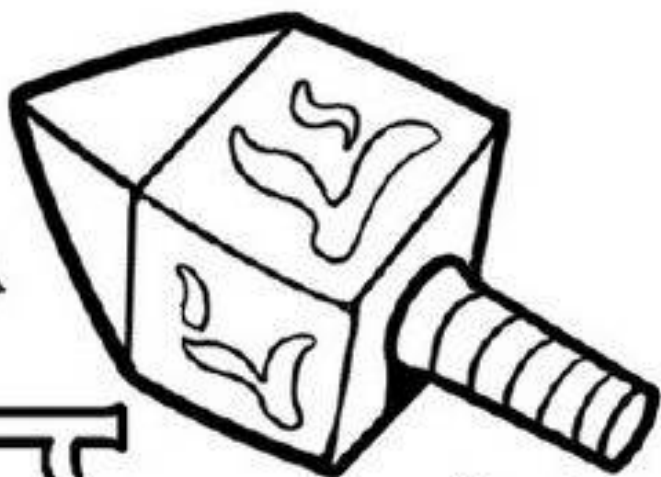
# CHANUKAH BINGO
