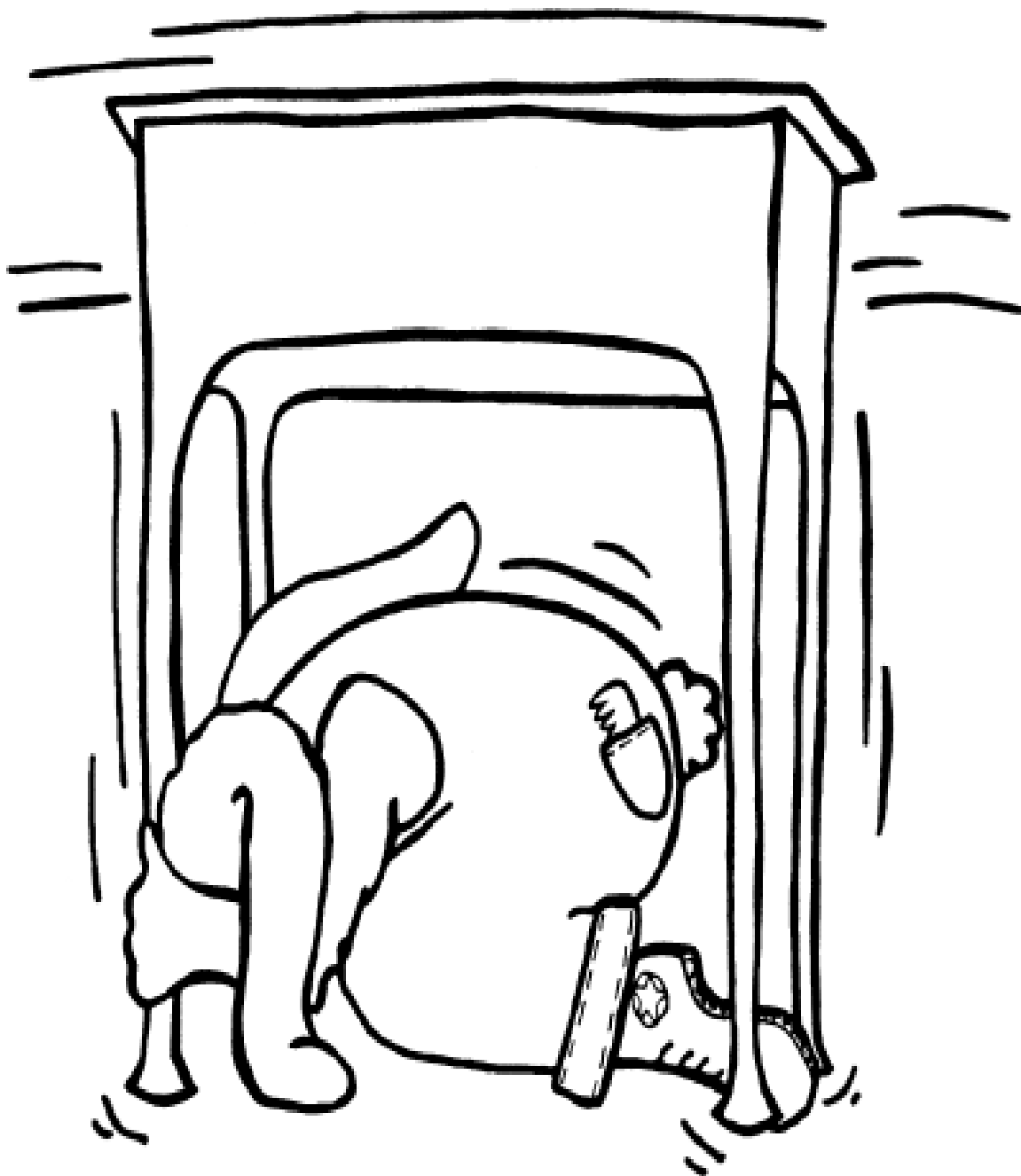

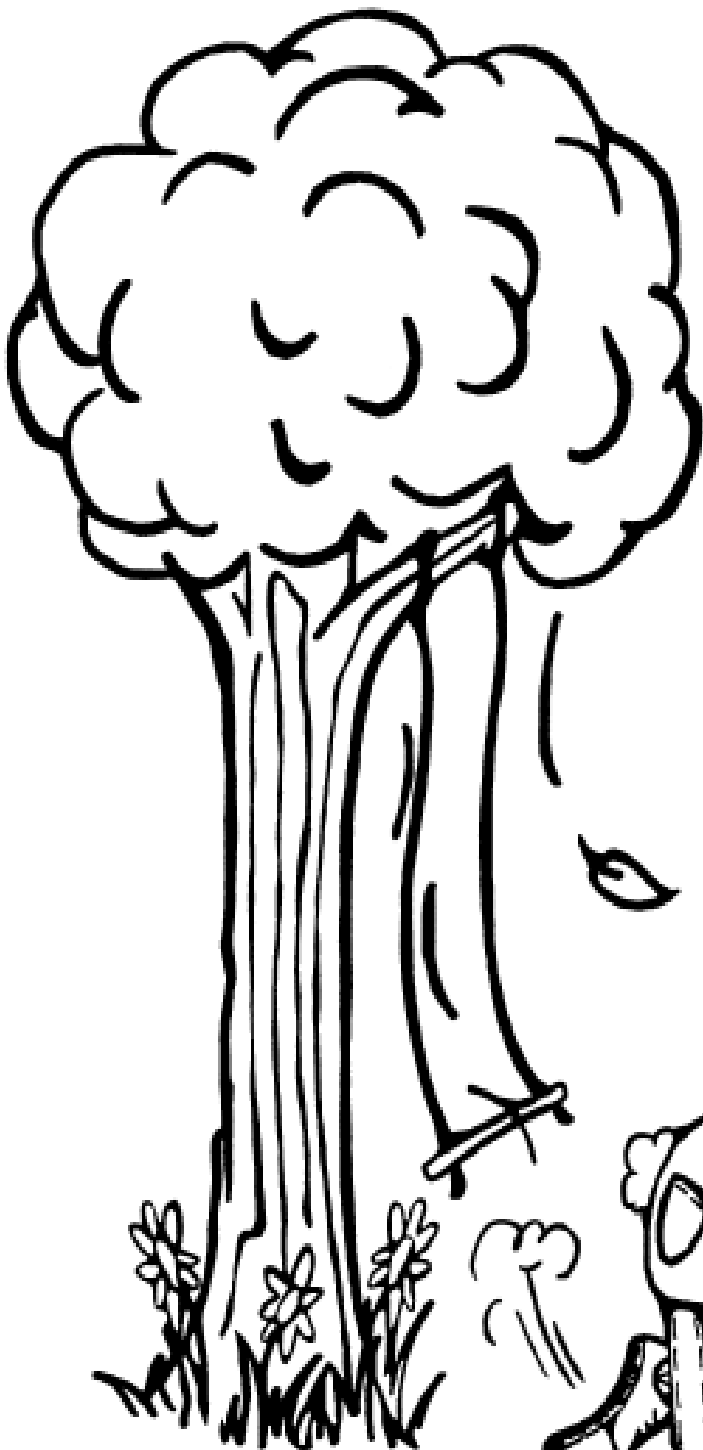
What do I do when the ground shakes!?

when the earth quakes!*



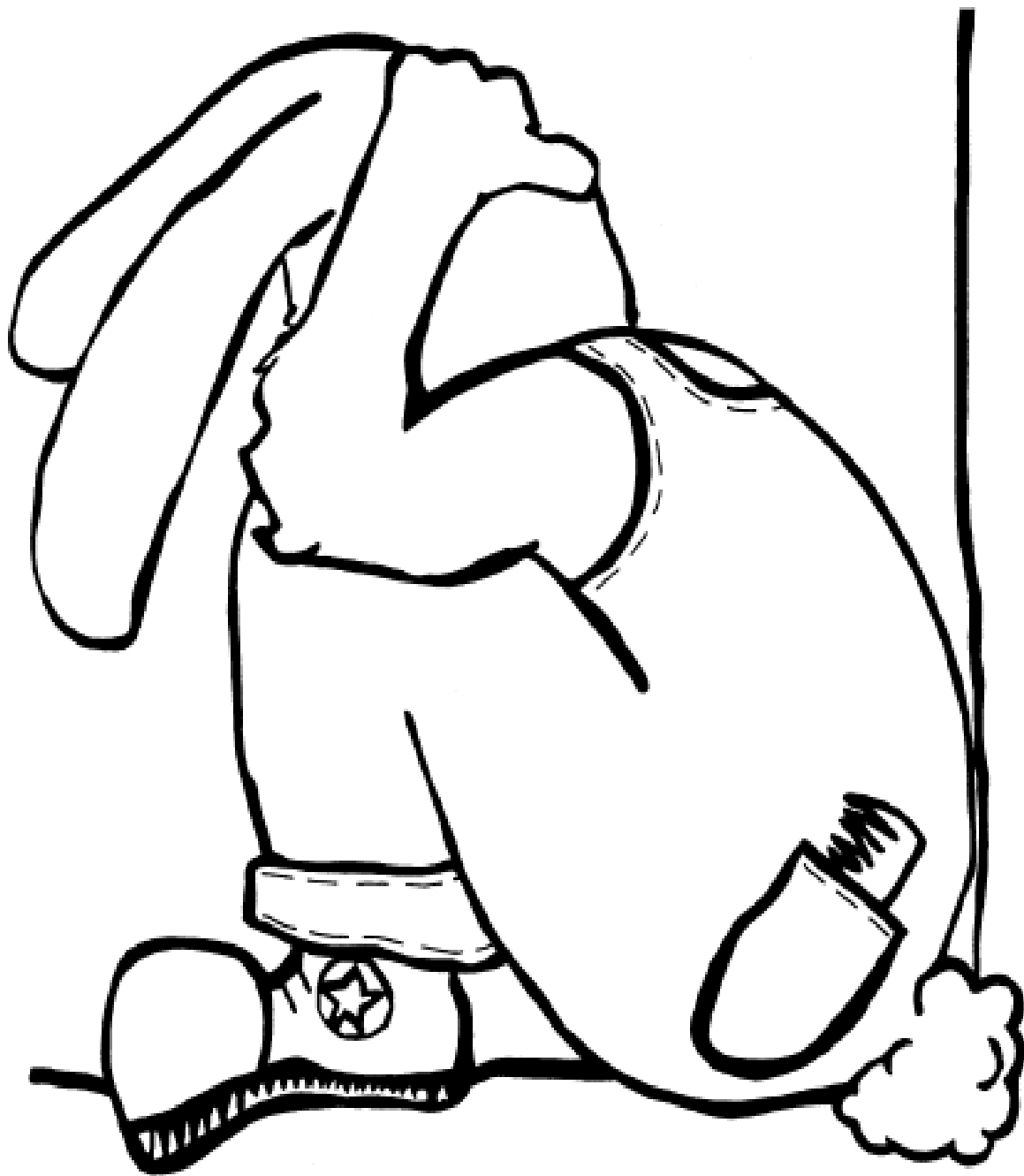


*When at my desk I've been told
to quickly "drop, cover and hold."*

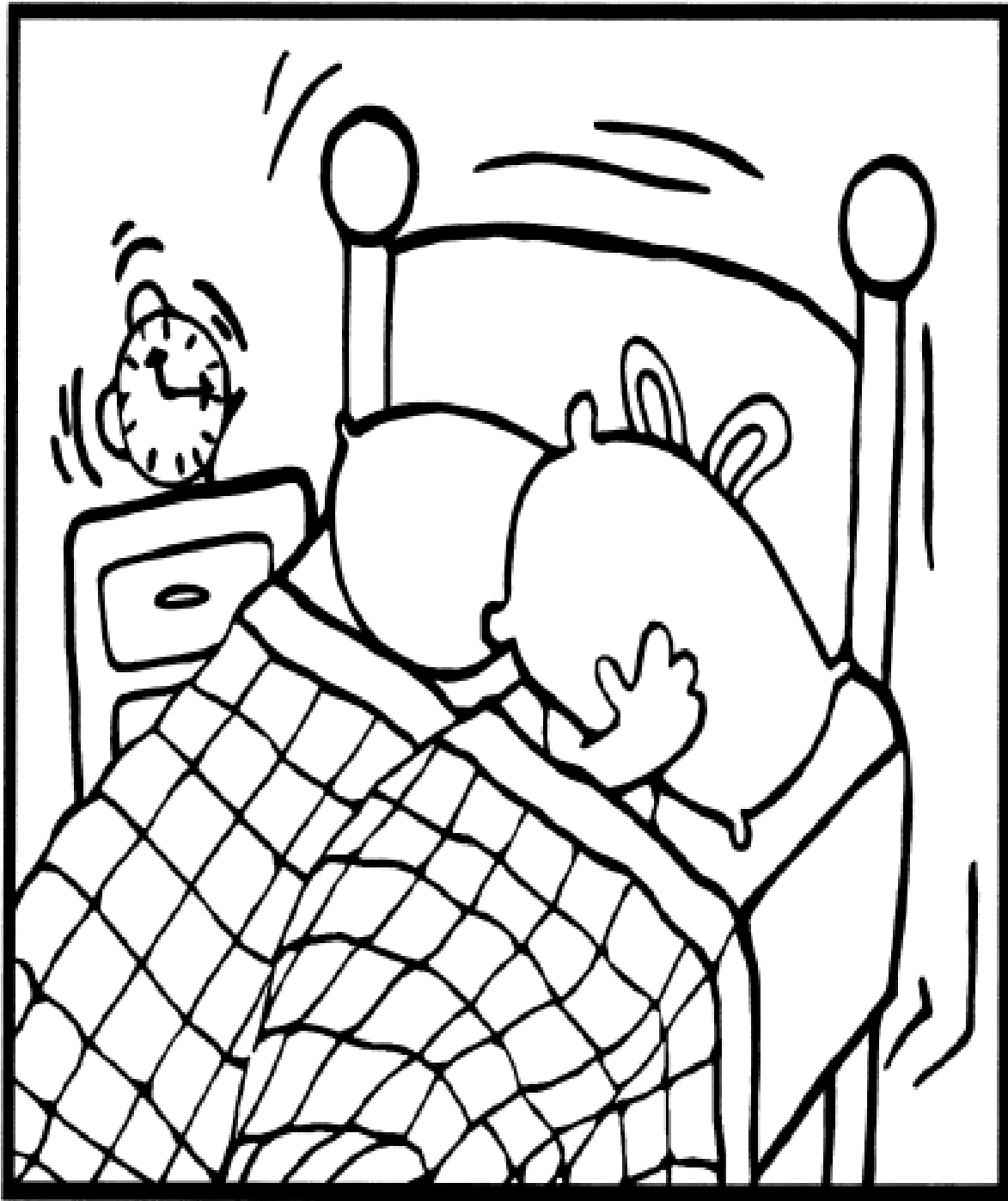


*"When outside,"

and curl up like a ball.*

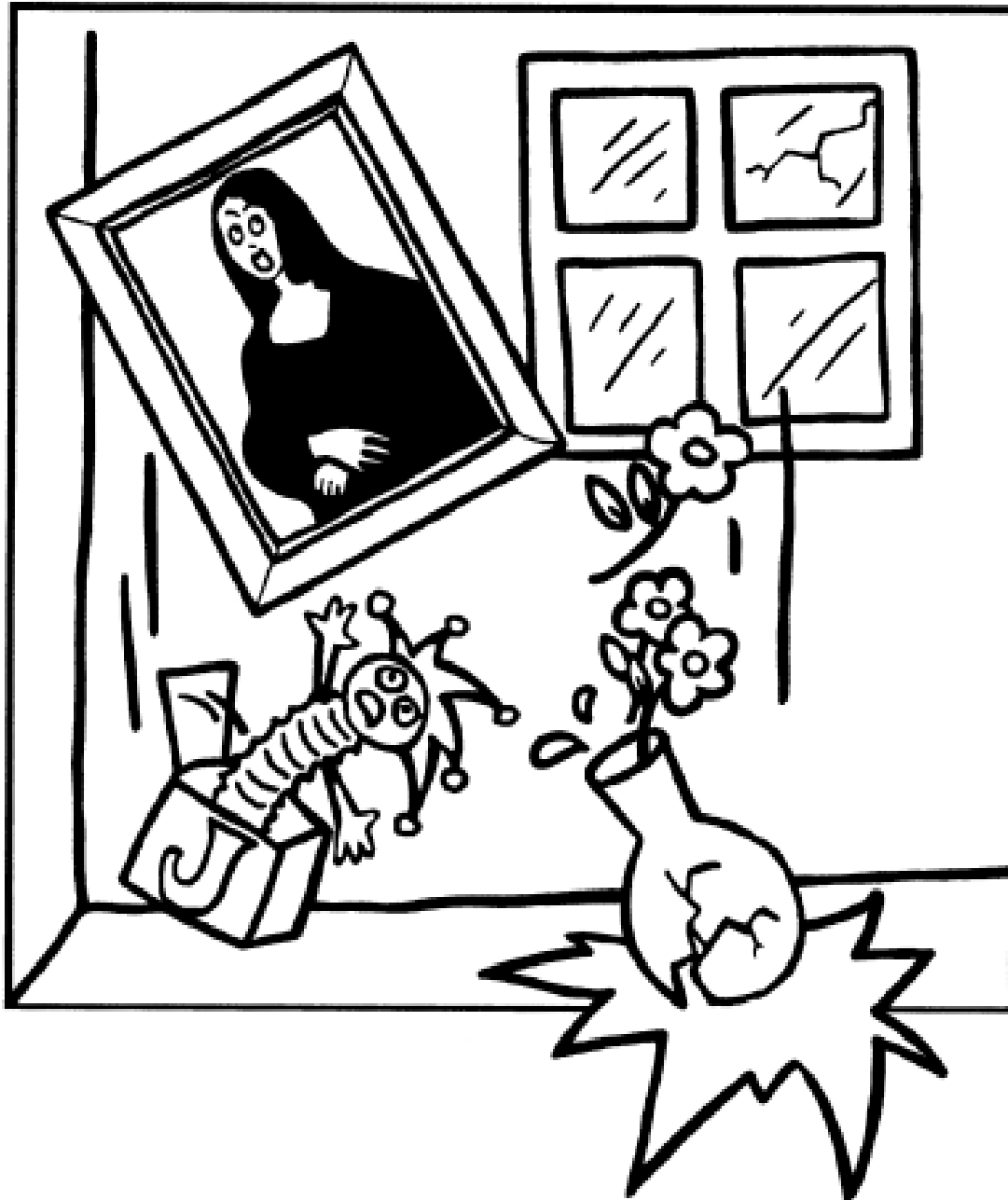


*If the earth starts to shake and I'm in bed,

when the earth starts to shake,*

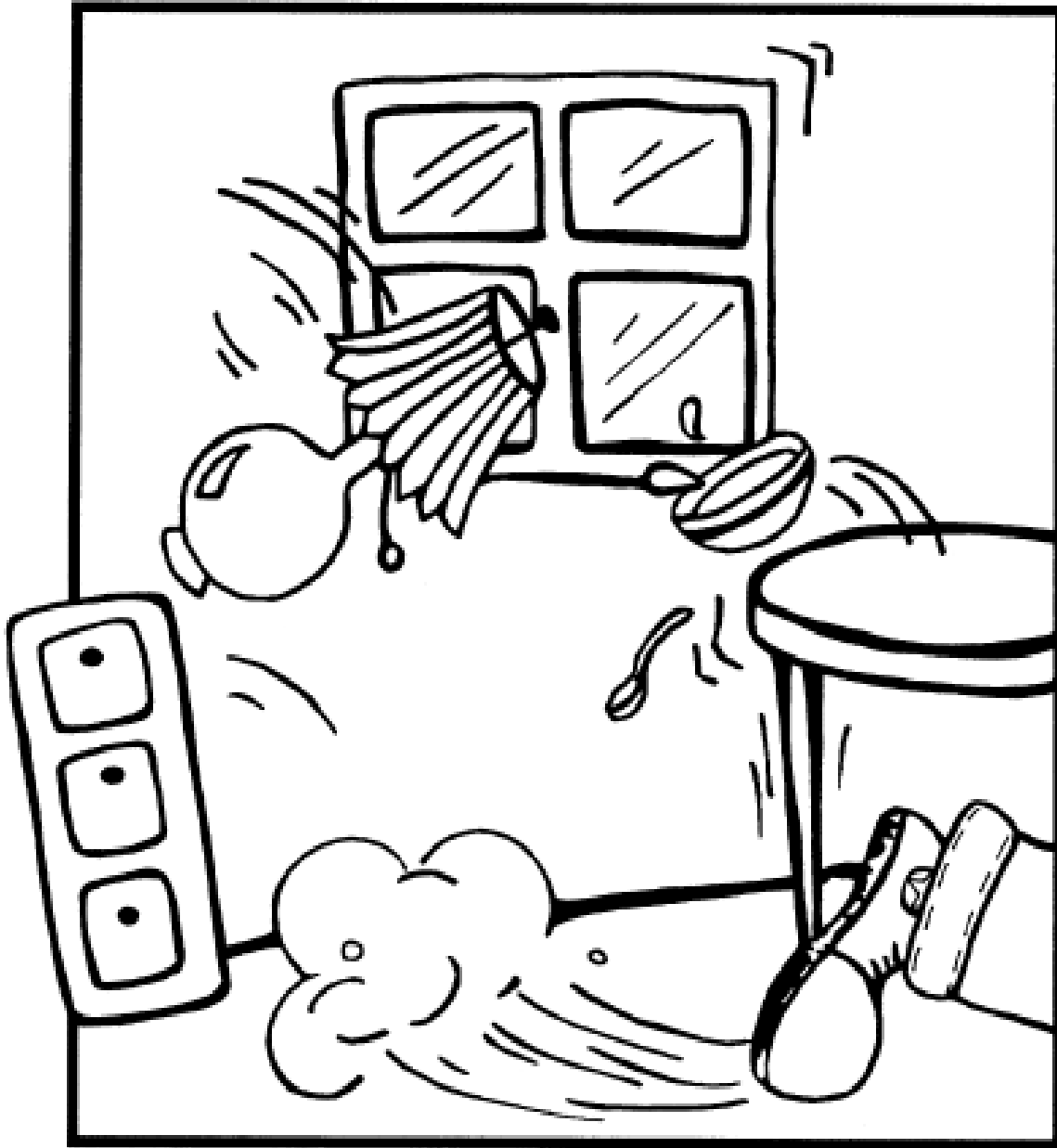


your biggest dangers are things that fall or break.

as quick as a mouse.*

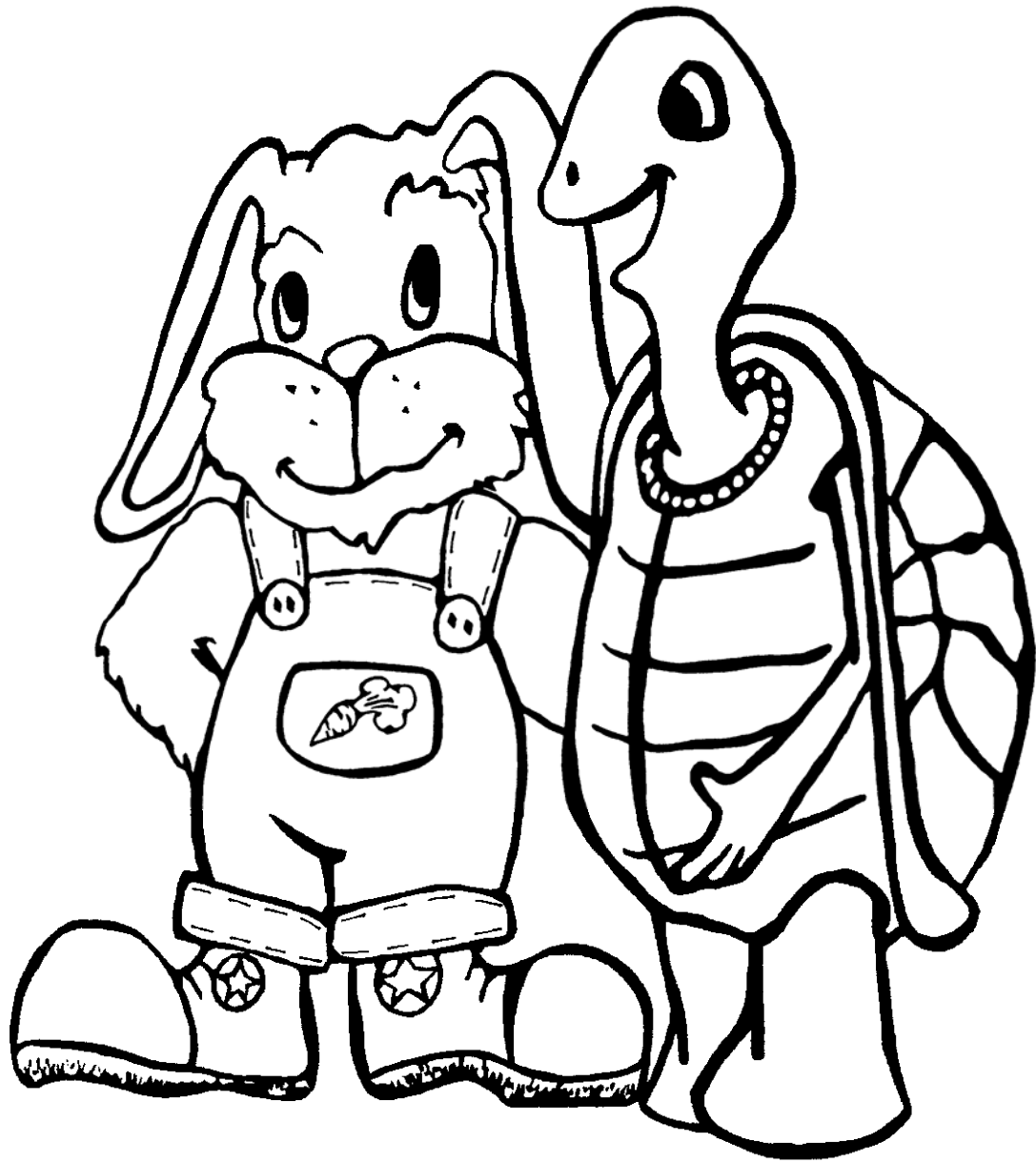
*When the earth starts to shake,
