- supplemental food and nutrition programs
- shelter and housing options and utilities assistance
- emergency information and disaster relief
- employment and education opportunities
- services for veterans
- health care, vaccination and health epidemic information
- addiction prevention and rehabilitation programs
- reentry help for ex-offenders
- support groups for individuals with mental illnesses or special needs
- a safe, confidential path out of physical and/or emotional domestic abuse

2018 2-1-1 IMPACT

In 2018, 2-1-1s across the U.S. made more than 12.8 million connections to help.

Referrals were most often made for housing or utilities assistance; physical or mental health services; assistance finding and obtaining employment; and services to address and prevent homelessness. The 2-1-1 network also answers dozens of crisis hotlines, including the National Suicide Prevention Lifeline.

As of 2018, 2-1-1 is available to 94.2% of the U.S. population.
