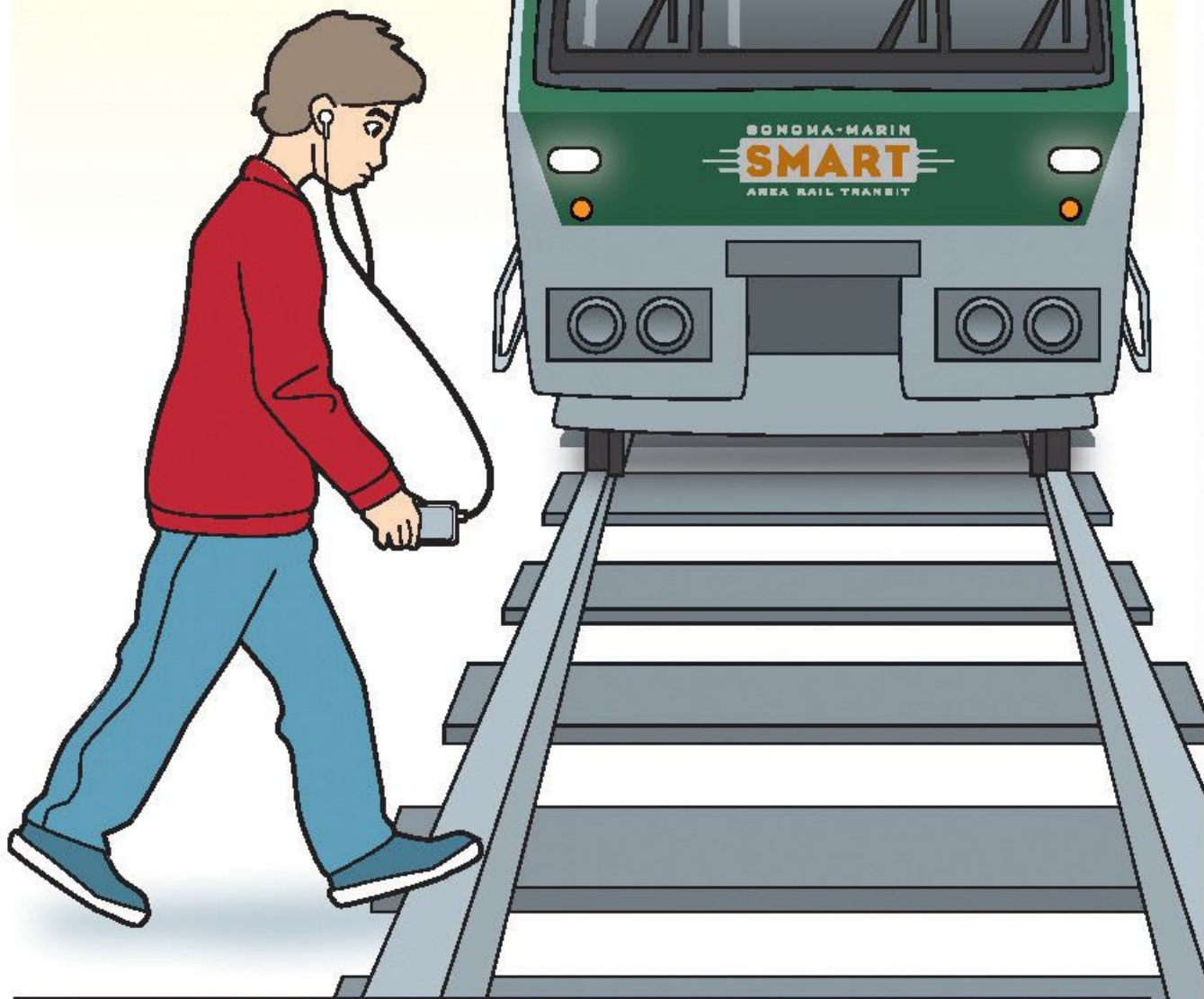

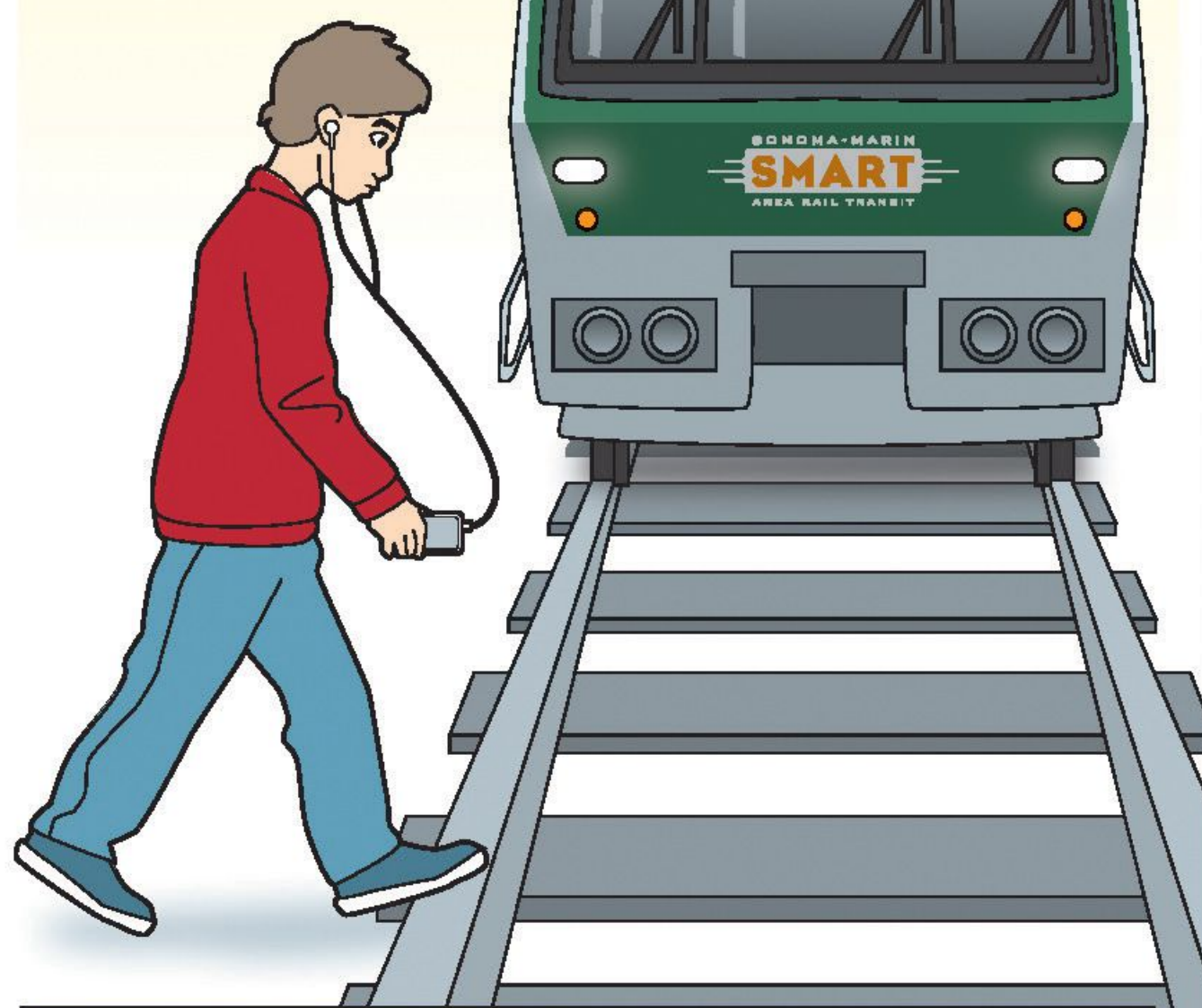
Remember to tell your family and friends how to be safe around railroad tracks: You could save a life!

The railroad track in Sonoma and Marin Counties is now an active railroad. Do you know the Rail Safety Rules?



HEADPHONE ALERT:

Wearing headphones or ear buds around tracks prevents you from hearing warning bells! By the time a train operator sees you on the tracks, it is too late to stop the train in time to avoid hitting you!

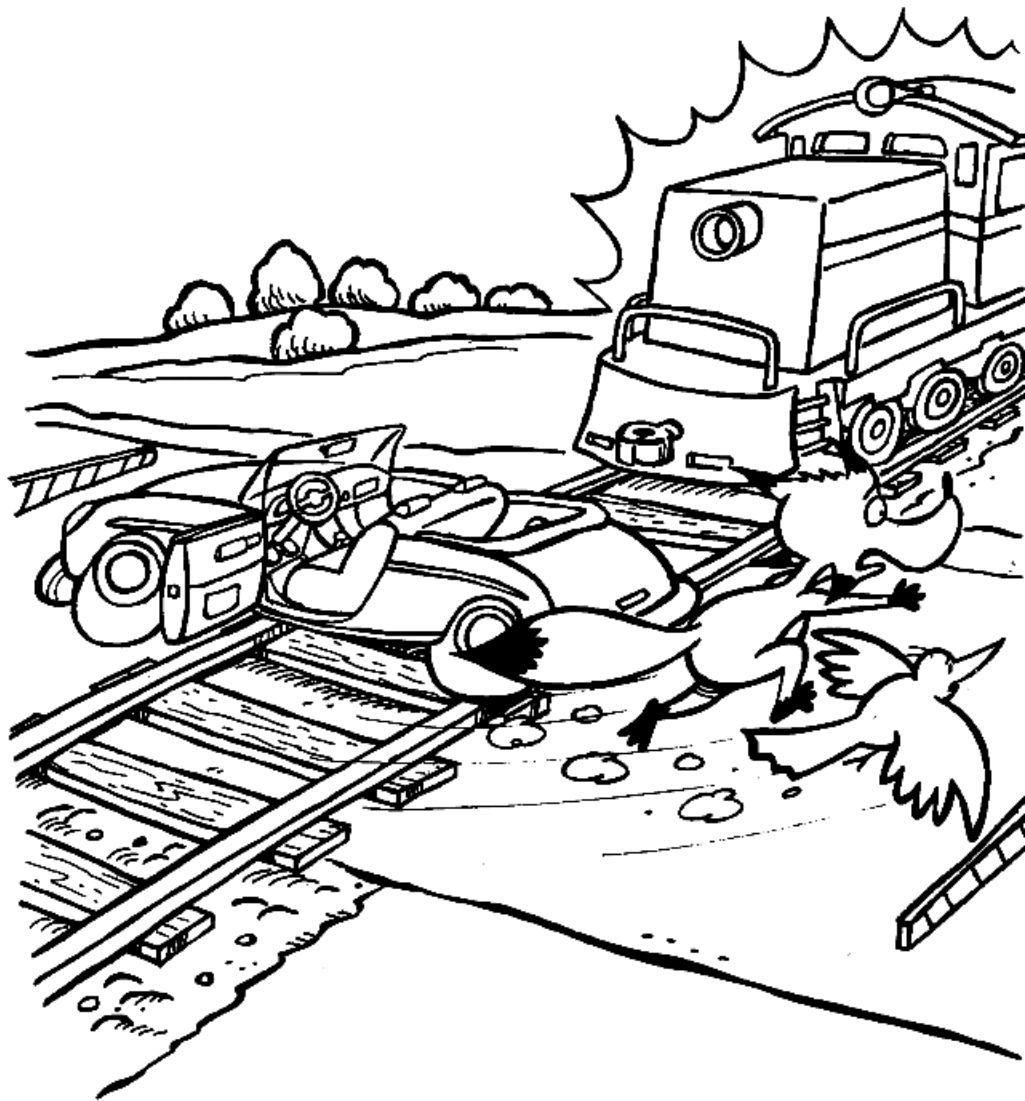

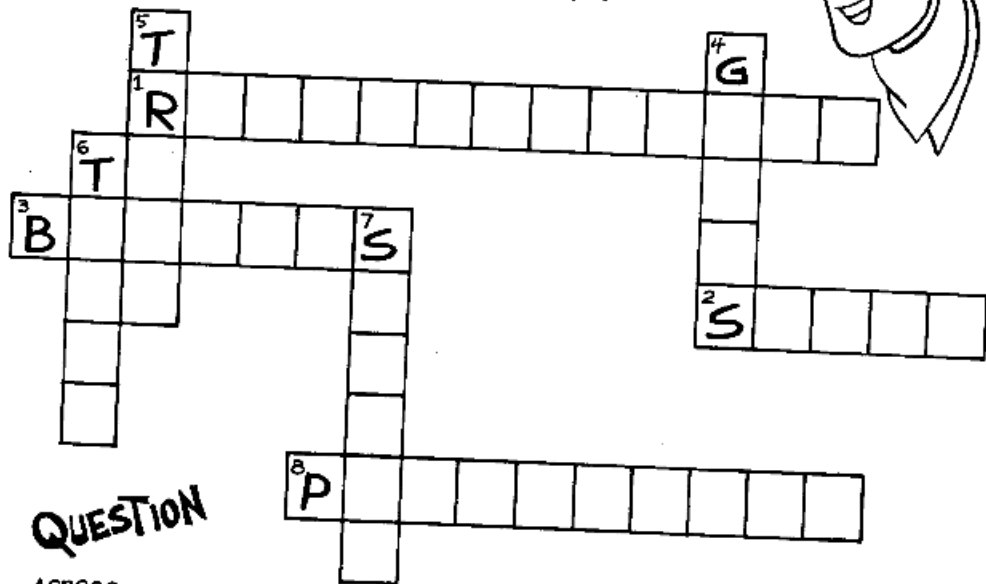

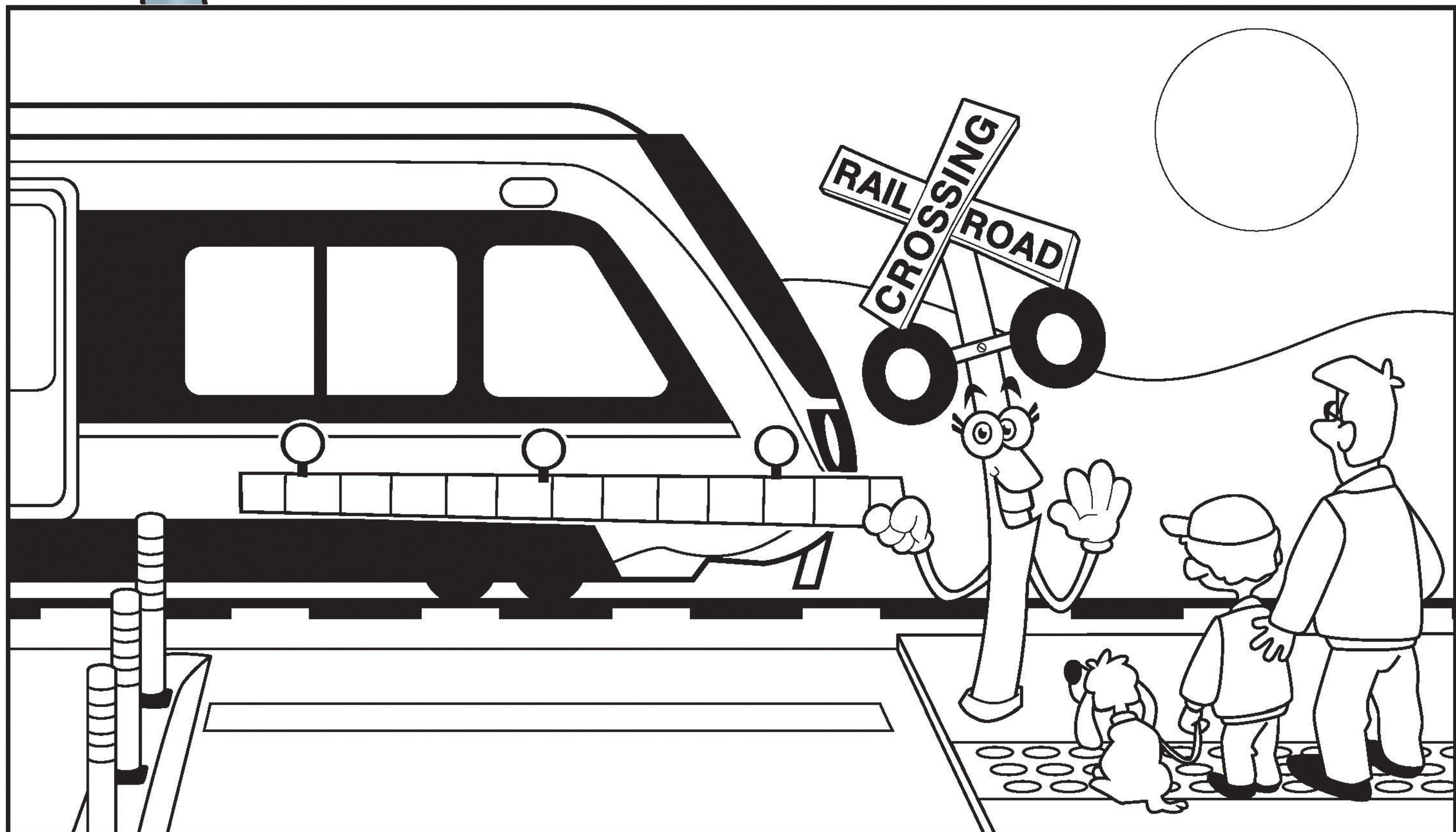


Crissy Crossbuck's Track SMART Rules:

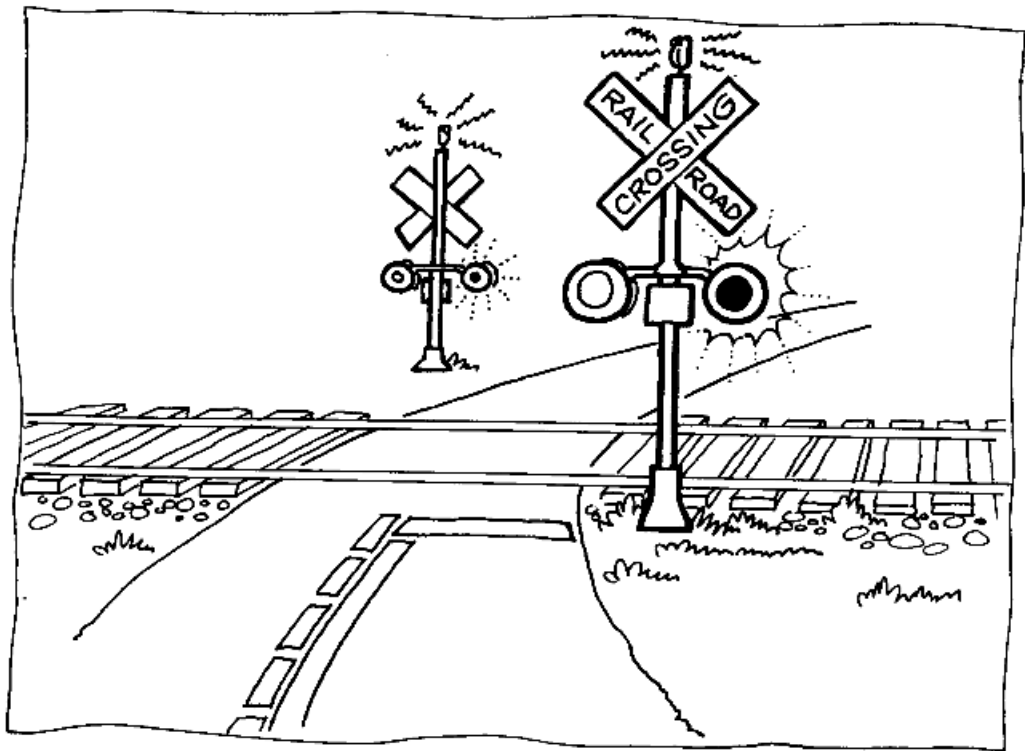


THINK SAFETY FIRST.

Always allow people to exit first, before you board.
- **Drivers should never stop on the tracks.**

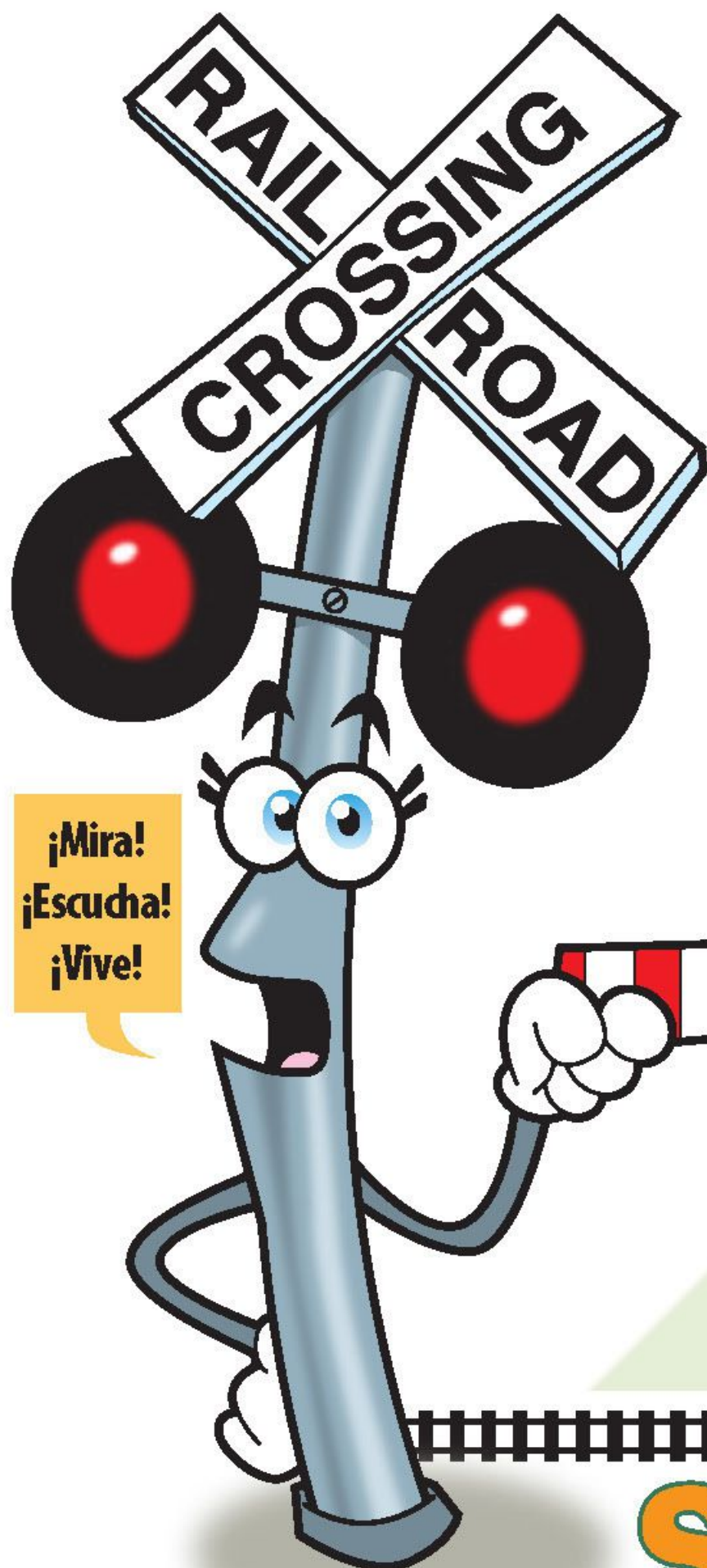

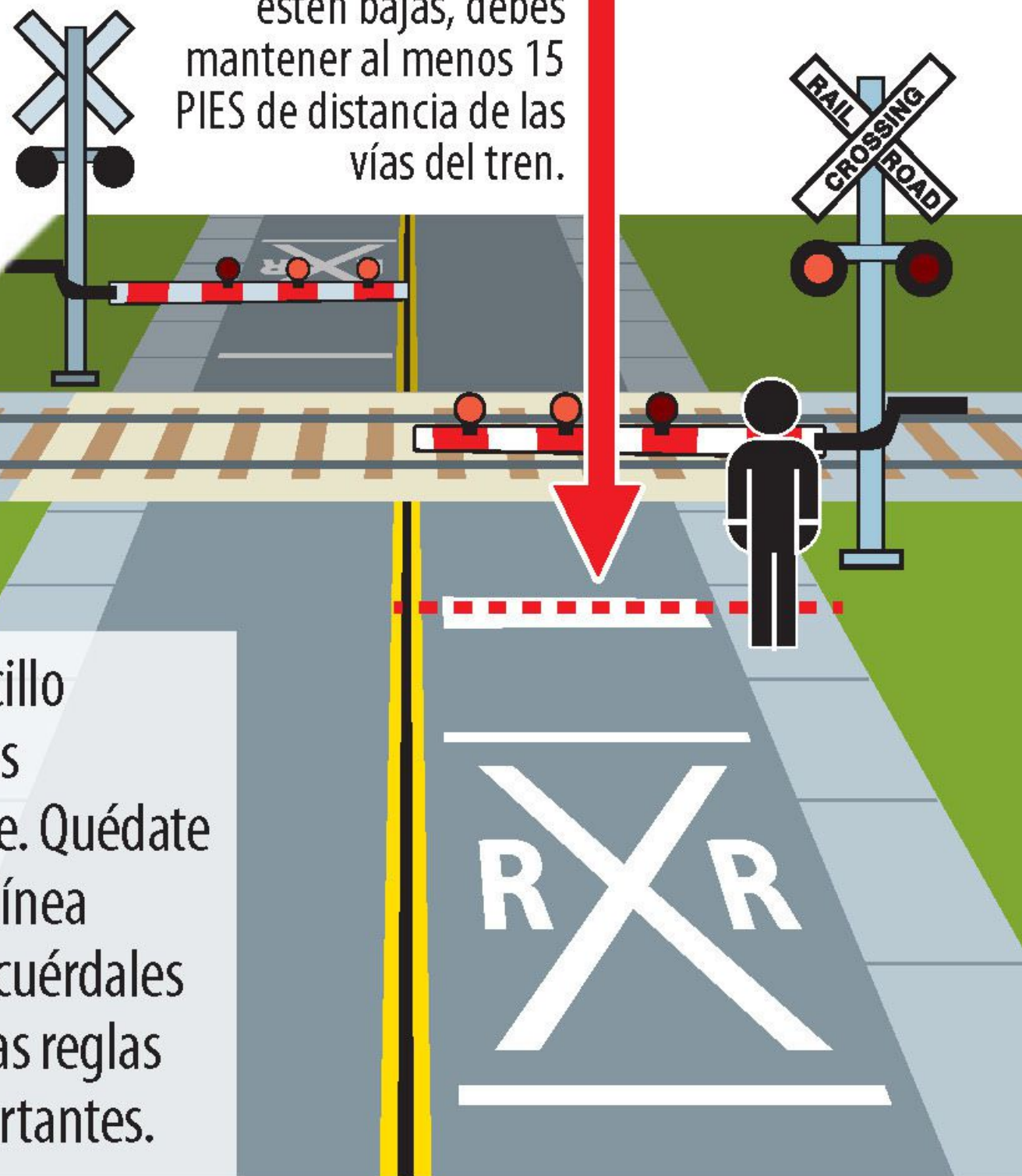


CRISSEY CROSSBUCK TE RECUERDA QUE:

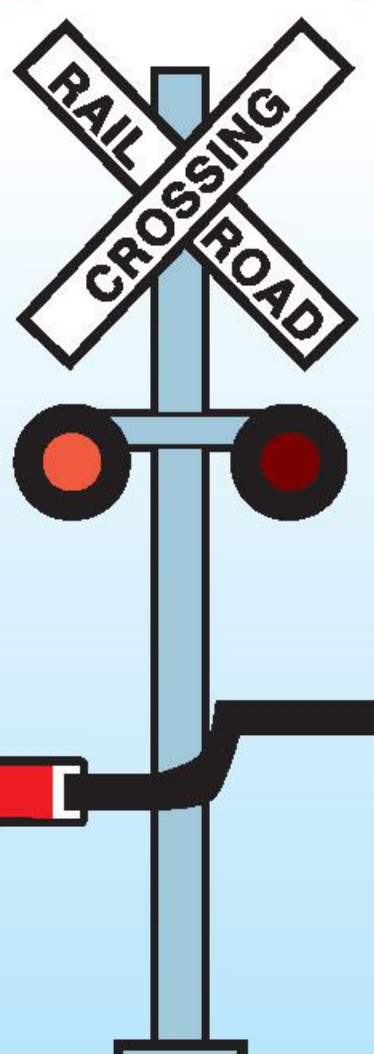

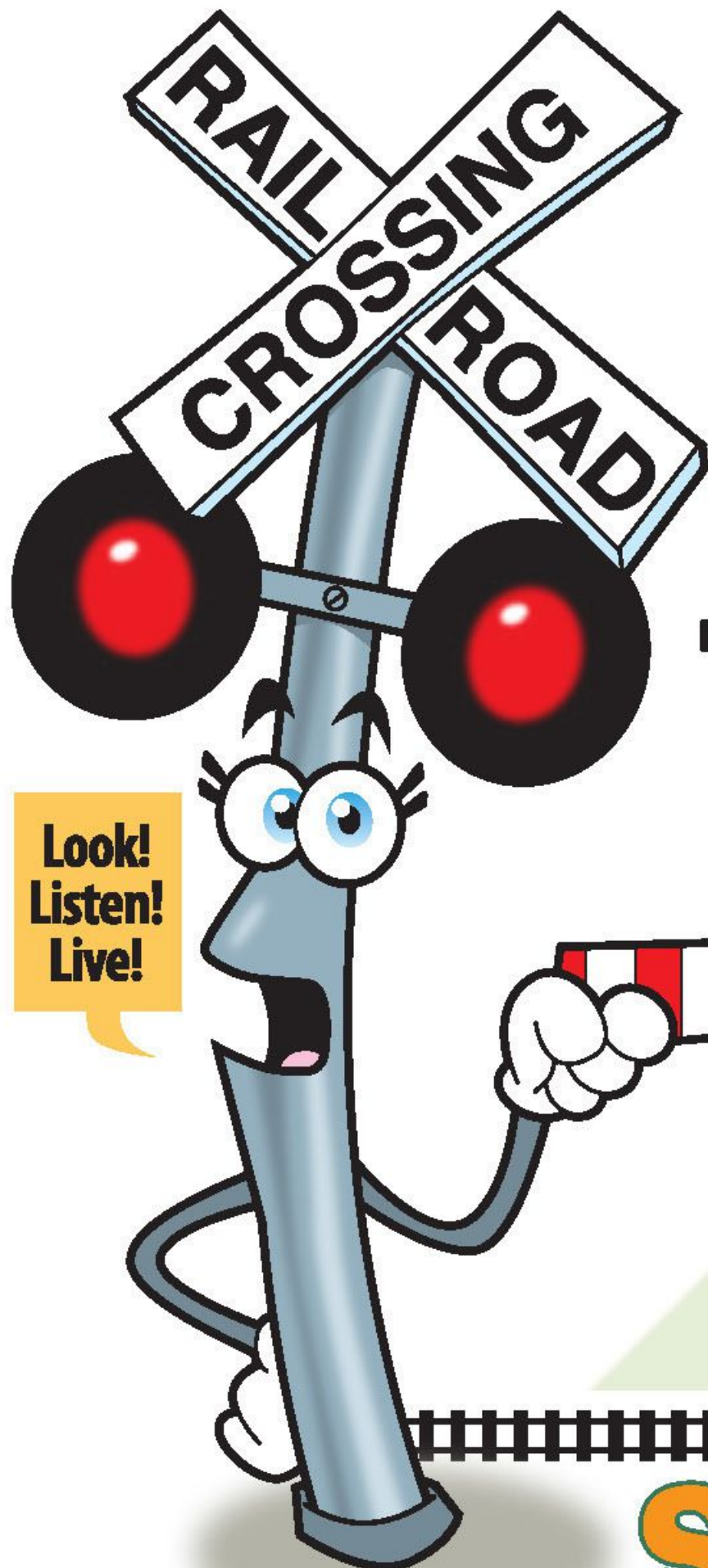

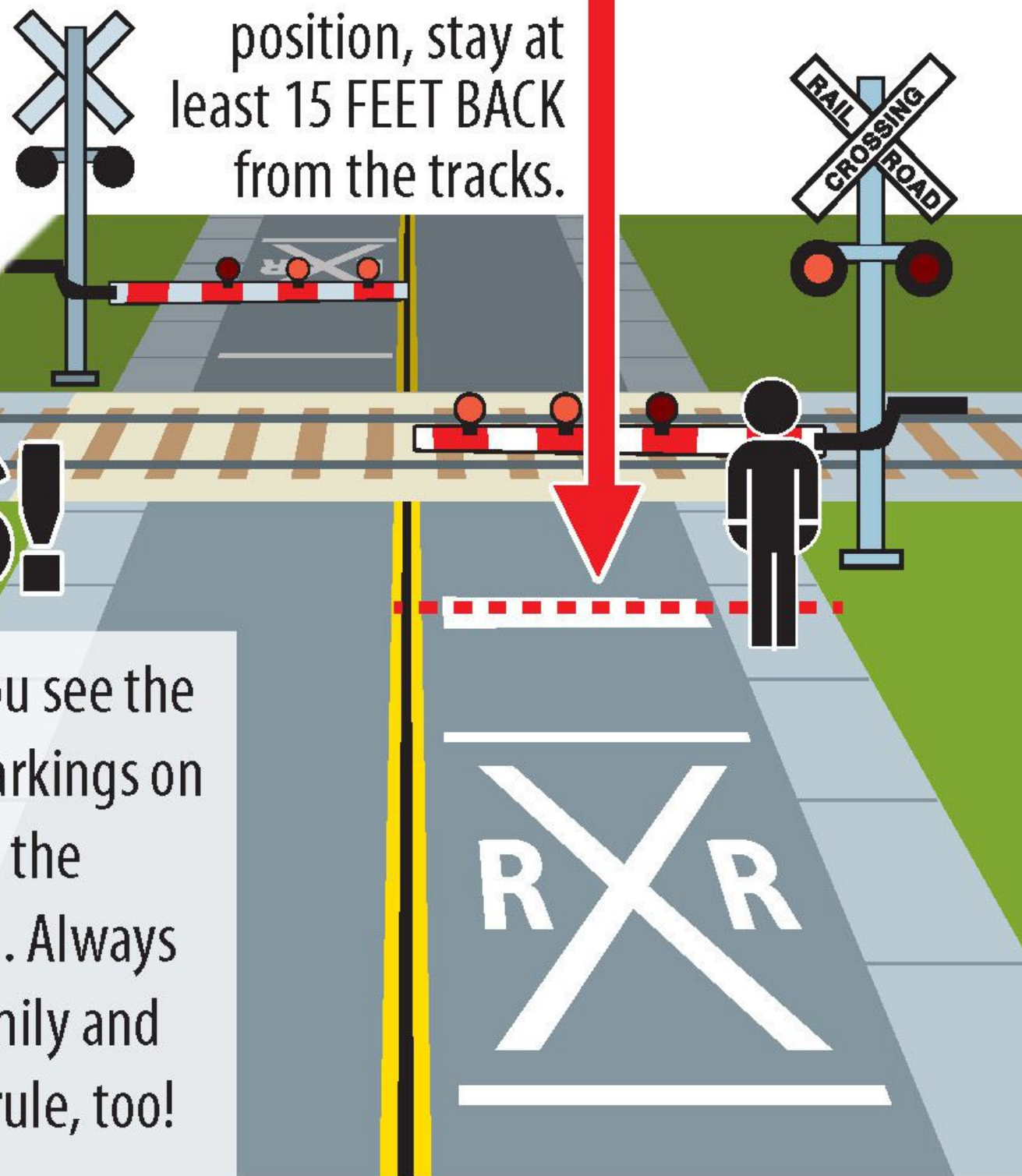




CRISSEY CROSSBUCK REMINDS YOU:

When the gate is in the down position, stay at least 15 FEET BACK from the tracks.

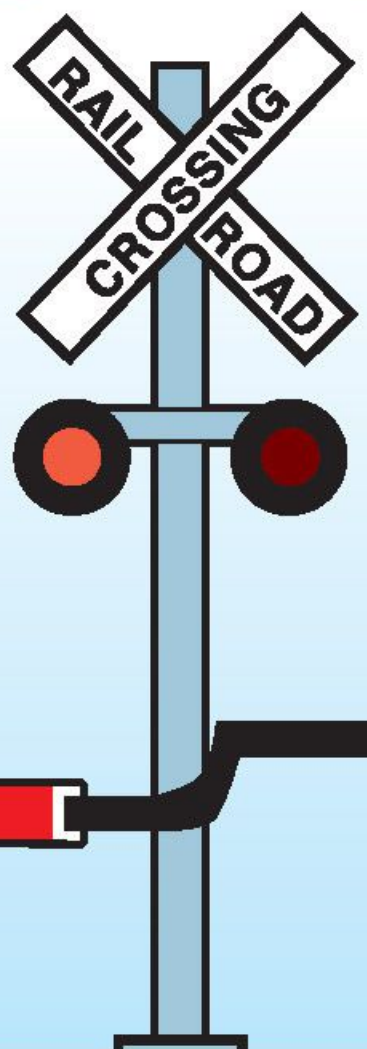


Staying back 15 feet is easy when you see the railroad crossing markings on the street. Stand on the sidewalk next to the white stop line. Always be track SMART and remind your family and friends about this important safety rule, too!

Operation Lifesaver Activity Pages - Answers

WHAT DO THE SIGNS MEAN? When you connect the dots you make a railroad **crossing signal and gate**. When the lights are flashing and the gate is down it means you must stop and wait for the train to go by. This is what it looks like:



WHO AM I? I am a crossbuck! A crossbuck sign tells you to slow down, look and listen for a train. If a train is coming you must stop and let the train go by before crossing the tracks. This is what the **crossbuck** looks like:
