Mellody Hobson Lucas(born April 3, 1969) is an American businesswoman who is the president of <u>Ariel Investments</u>. She is the former chairman of <u>DreamWorks Animation</u>, [1], having stepped down after negotiating the acquisition of Dream Works Animation SKG, Inc., by NBCUniversal in August, 2016. In 2017, she became the first African-American woman to head The Economic Club of Chicago. [2]

Early life

Hobson was born in <u>Chicago</u>, <u>Illinois</u>. She attended Ogden Elementary School and later was educated at <u>St. Ignatius College Prep</u> high school, and subsequently attended the <u>Princeton University</u> graduating from the <u>Woodrow Wilson School of Public</u> and International Afairs.


Soon after her graduation from Princeton in 1991, Hobson joined <u>Ariel Investments</u> as an intern and rose to become the firm's senior vice president and director of marketing. In 2000, she ascended to become the president of Ariel, a Chicago investment firm that manages over \$13 billion in assets.^[3] It is also one of the

largest African American-owned money management and mutual fund companies in the United State^[A]

Hobson is also Chairman of the Board of Trustees of Ariel Investment Trust. She is a regular contributor on financial issues on <u>CBS</u> This Morning and a spokesperson for the annual Ariel/Schwab Black Investor Survey

Hobson serves on the board of many organizations, including JPMorgan Chase & Co, the Chicago Public Education Fund, the Lucas Museum of Narrative Art and the Sundance Institute. She is also a director of the Starbucks Corporation, The Estée Lauder Companies Inc. Hobson has been acclaimed in selections such as *Time*'s 2015 Time 100 List, the magazine's annual list of the one hundred most influential people in the world)., *Esquire*'s "20 Leaders of the Future" (1992), Working Women Magazine's "20 Under 30" (1992), the World Economic Forums "Global Leaders of Tomorrow" (2001), *Esquire*'s "America's Best and Brightest" (2002), *The Wall Street Journal*'s 50 "Women to Watch" (2004).

Hobson created and hosted a show on ABC on May 29, 2009, called *Unbroke: What You Need to Know About Money*, featuring celebrities such as the Jonas Brothers, Oscar the Grouchand Samuel L. Jackson^[7]

Actress <u>Vanessa L. Williams</u> based her character, self-made businesswoman Courtney Paige (in the American television drama, <u>The Good Wife</u>), on Hobson, studying her via Hobson's <u>TED talks</u>. [8] In 2017, Hobson was named to head the Economic Club of Chicago, the first African-American woman to do so. [9]

On August 6, 2017 Hobson guest hosted CBS Sunday Morning's annual "Money Issue" episod^[10]

On June 4, 2018, Hobson was named as Vice-Chair of Starbucks Corporation^[11]

Mellody Hobson was inducted as a Laureate of <u>The Lincoln Academy of Illinois</u> and awarded the <u>Order of Lincoln</u> (the State's highest honor) by the Governor of Illinois in 2018^[12]

Personal life

Hobson began dating film director and producer <u>George Lucas</u> in 2006, after they met at a business conference.^{[13][14][15][16][17]} Hobson and Lucas announced their engagement in January 2013,^[18] and were married on June 22, 2013, at Lucas' <u>Skywalker Ranch.^[19] They have one daughter together Everest Hobson Lucas, who was born viæurrogacy in August 2013.^[20]</u>

She recently appeared on the *Jack Good Show* in August 2017, where she accepted the City of Birmingham's deepest appreciation for her charitable work with Birmingham's Bright Leaders of Thorrow. [22]
